House Wines

- 1 **Sauvignon-Semillon, San Elian, 2014/15** (2) **Bottle £13.95**
Central Valley, Chile
175ml **£4.20**
On the nose, tropical fruit aromas whilst on the palate, citrus fruits, a light body and a balanced acidity. 12.5% vol
- 2 **Cabernet-Merlot, San Elian, 2014/15** (B) **Bottle £13.95**
Central Valley, Chile
175ml **£4.20**
On the nose, aromas of black cherries, whilst on the palate, juicy red and black fruits combine with a medium body and soft tannins. 13% vol

Italian

- 3 **Chianti, Classico Riserva** (C) **Bottle £19.95**
Tuscany, Italy
A classic, traditional Chianti Classico full of bright cherry fruit overlaid with herbal notes of myrtle, marjoram and thyme. A little liquorice earthiness offers complexity to complement the fine tannin structure. Very elegant.
- 4 **Pinot Grigio, Laroma, Araldica, 2013/14** (2) **Bottle £15.95**
Venezie, Italy
Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas.
A classic Italian white wine. 12.5% vol

French

- 5 **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine, Chereau Carré, 2013/14** (1) **Bottle £15.95**
Loire, France
Dry, crisp, and fresh with a sea-breeze and light almond character.
Carries a light and easy natural style. 12% vol
- 6 **Chablis 'Bieville', Louis Moreau, 2014/15** (1) **Bottle £24.50**
Burgundy, France
Produced by Louis Moreau, this fresh, crisp Chardonnay has wonderful citrus and mineral notes with a nutty hint on the finish. 12.5% vol
- 7 **Sancerre, Domaine Neveu, 2013/14** (1) **Bottle £25.95**
Loire, France
A classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. 12.5% vol

German

- 8 **Piesporter Michelsberg, Franz Reh, 2013/14** (4) **Bottle £14.95**
Mosel, Germany
Fresh, light, semi-dry wine with neat sweetness and focused Mosel acidity. 9% vol

New World White

- 9 **Sauvignon Blanc, Taworri, 2014/15** (2) **Bottle £16.95**
Marlborough, New Zealand
Benchmark New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with all the classic notes this style of wine is famed for - crisp zesty character, gooseberry fruit, grassy notes and utterly delicious. 13% vol
- 10 **Chardonnay, Urmeneta, 2014/15** (2) **Bottle £15.95**
Central Valley, Chile
This intense Chardonnay shows aromas of peach and pineapple, plus a hint of banana that all blend perfectly with sweet notes of vanilla. 13% vol

New World Red

- 11 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Urmeneta, 2013/14** (C) **Bottle £15.95**
Central Valley, Chile
Dark, ruby colour, full of red fruit aromas, perfectly mixed with sweet vanilla and coconut notes. It has a fresh mouthfeel, medium body, soft tannins and a long, pleasant finish. 13.5% vol
- 12 **Shiraz, Rumours, 2014/15** (C) **Bottle £16.95**
Australia
Sweet cherry fruit with silky cocoa and chocolate tannins. Intense black cherries are supported by hints of vanilla and earthy aromas making this an Aussie Shiraz worth discovering. 12.5% vol

Rosé Wine

- 13 **Pinot Grigio Rosé, Laroma, Araldica, 2013/14** (2) **Bottle £15.95**
Pavia, Italy
As pleasing a Pinot Grigio rosé as you could find. It has freshness, delicacy and rose-scented charm all the way through. 12% vol
- 14 **Mateus Rosé, NV** (3) **Bottle £14.95**
Estremadura, Portugal
This pretty wine continues to hold a popular spot in the market, delivering the bright, semi-sweet fruit with its lightly festive bubbles. 11% vol

Spanish Red

- 15 **Rioja Reserva** (C) **Bottle £19.95**
Rioja, Spain
A full bodied red aged in oak barrels, typical of a great Rioja.

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

- 16 **Prosecco Spumante, Tenuta Ca' Bolani, NV** (1) **Bottle £18.95**
Italy
Pale straw-yellow and a fine, clear mousse with delicate bubbles. Exuberantly fruity, aromatic, with apple notes. Well-balanced and easy-drinking with the delicate almond note typical of the grape variety. (1) 11% vol
- 17 **Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial, NV** (1) **Bottle £42.95**
Champagne, France
Possibly the most well known of all Champagnes worldwide. Classic, old fashioned style. 12% vol

WINE GUIDE:

White & Rosé wines are designated numbers 1 to 9 with 1 being the driest and 9 being the sweetest.

Red wines are designated letters A to E with A being the lightest and softest and E being the deepest and fullest with a concentrated flavour.

Vintage and % volumes may change according to availability.

Wines on this list may contain sulphites, egg or milk products. Please ask a member of staff should you require guidance.
